PM meets young peacemakers

Gordon Brown has met a group of young people involved in a Metropolitan police youth project aimed at promoting peace and cultural exchange.

Today's visit to Downing Street was part of a tour of the capital for the teens from Indonesia, Israel and Palestine, the UK and the USA after a week spent at an outward bound centre in Wales.

Organised in conjunction with UK charity Encompass, the Westminster Reconciliation project is the first of its kind for the area, and brings together young people from different backgrounds to promote cultural awareness and peaceful co-existence.

Encompass was set up in 2002 by friends and family of Daniel Braden, one of the Britons killed in the Bali bombings.
